# Sabbatical Planning with Great Talent

Bl's staff is an all-star team. We recently met to discuss the plans for my Sabbatical. As I looked around the table, I was reminded of the stability, creativity, and dedication of each member.

**Sandy Klein**, our executive director, has masterfully tended to the myriad details of CBI administration

for the past sixteen years, having joined five years before as a member. She is our first full time executive director. A Social Worker by training she relates to members and fellow staff with genuine care and competence. Sandy also holds a Master of Public Administration enabling her and our administrative staff to efficiently meet our congregants' needs.

Helene Coulter is our operations manager. Helene grew up at Temple Sharon and has taught in our religious school for 11 years. A CBI member for close to a decade before accepting the bookkeeping portfolio, she has expanded her role over the ensuing decade to include computer trouble-shooting, B'nai Mitzvah coordination (including Davener's Clinic), finalizing service participation and so much more at her talented initiative.

Ana Cottle is our operations specialist for close to three years. Ana grew up in our religious school, celebrating her bat mitzvah at CBI. She attended Cal Berkeley, where she graduated with honors in Comparative Literature and Judaic Studies. synagogue educator. Her primary guiding responsibility is religious school. In recent years she re-envisioned our Hebrew High program and co-initiated countywide Israel education for teens called "Knowledge for College." She serves on the national board of Synagogue Educators, having co-hosted the annual gathering last year in Los Angeles. Ordained as a Rabbi four years ago at the Academy for Jewish Religion in LA, she also fills in when needed at congregant funerals and works with our b'nai mitzvah families. Rabbi Foonberg guides a talented religious school staff of caring teachers.



Barbara Sherman has served as our Youth Director for 27 years and continues to have a rare gift for mentoring youth. Once again this year, our USY chapter won the coveted Chapter of Excellence, identifying our chapter as a model for the 40 chapters in our fivestate region. To watch our USY teens lead Friday night services or participate in our third Shabbat of the month morning service is to have goosebumps. This year Barbara will mark 20 years of Camp B'nai Ruach. the wonderful summer day camp that she initiated and so capably runs.

Sharon Alkin directs our Child Development Center. She previously served in the classroom with our oldest preschoolers. Before coming to CBI she directed a preschool in Los Angeles. She too, is enormously well organized and brings genuine warmth and common sense to managing her staff and meeting the needs of our children and their families. Sharon guides and nurtures her diverse, warm, cooperative team of preschool teachers.

Nancy Cedar, with a degree in business from Cal State Fullerton, is the Administrative Assistant to the Child Development Center for the past 17 years. Her husband, Carl Cedar, a music producer at Disneyland, leads services regularly on Friday

nights and Junior Congregation on Saturdays, helps lead our annual seder, and teaches Jewish music in our religious school.

There are so many others who work behind the scenes to insure excellence at CBI:

**Luis Garcia** is our Facility Manager for close to three years while attending Santa Ana College with a focus on engineering. He is amazing on the computer, including production of our videos. This summer he and his younger sister will serve as counselors at Camp B'nai Ruach.

Maria Rodriguez has managed our kitchen for close to 14 years. We have lunch after each morning

service and wonderful Shabbat dinners. Maria's staff works cooperatively to produce varied, tasty food and home-baked cakes.

**Miguel Rodriguez,** Maria's husband, is our custodian, who with great reliability keeps our facility clean and in order.

Sabbatical planning is a partnership between our staff

and board leaders. In particular, our current president, Tony Kravitz, and Beth Elster, a former president, have prepared a grid of all synagogue needs and are mapping out coverage. including each Shabbat and holiday. As Tony says, the Sabbatical year is an opportunity for the synagogue to also experiment and grow. Among the guest rabbis are Adam Greenwald (14 visits) and Micah Hyman (six), each with a national reputation for dynamic preaching. Tony, Beth, and I have met with our prayer leader and teacher, Amy Robinson Katz, to explore ways to increase musicality and energy in our services. Rabbi Foonberg will play an active role as part of the team for lifecycle events and pastoral care. We are blessed with a strong comfort Hesed Committee, including many "buddies" and a synagogue nurse.

Mark Twain said, "It usually takes more than three weeks to prepare a good impromptu speech" In that light, please know that there is much preparation going on to ensure that CBI remains vibrant and responsive during my Sabbatical. But most importantly, the trustworthiness of our quality staff - coupled with an experienced, talented board and committed community of congregants - ensures a synagogue of excellence for many years to come. \$\Pi\$
