RABBI SPITZ'S MESSAGE



"We Are All Here for a Visit"

This is the fourth year that we have launched a small-group discussion campaign during the fall season that builds on my High Holyday sermons. Because content matters, I have prepared a booklet as a starting point for each year's small group conversations. A group can be as small as two people or a gathering of a dozen or more. Hundreds of our congregants have participated in the small group discussions year after year. I do hope that if you have participated previously, you will host friends - congregants or not, individuals of any faith or not identified with any faith - for five conversations using this year's booklet. If this is your first opportunity to join in, whether

as host or participant, please do so. Our office will happily provide you with the materials or connect you with a conversation group.

This year's booklet is entitled "Character matters! Mensch-Making Through Five Small-Group Conversations." Religion at its best is the forum for considering the values that constitute our best selves and redrafting our negative behaviors. These five chapters offer you an appreciation of your signature character traits and a safe setting for improvement. Of the many attributes of being a mensch, we will focus on the categories of justice, kindness, and humility. As a transition, we will examine the trait of curiosity, for out of the desire to know ourselves and our impact on the world around us emerges our wisdom and willfulness, elevating our goodness. This booklet's chosen traits of "character matters" emerge from the words of the prophet Micah (6:8). He preached over 2700 years ago in Northern Israel and quoted God as saying:

It has been told you, O human, what is good, and what the Ever-Present-One requires of you: Only to do justly, and to love mercy, and to

walk humbly with your God.

More than our possessions or work achievements, our attributes of character, especially how we are present in relationships, will characterize the quality of our lives. A place to start is by noticing what behaviors you most admire in others and then seeking to emulate those types of action. The five sets of guided conversations in this booklet are intended to raise your awareness and motivate you to cultivate your menschlichkeit, the Yiddish for "core goodness."

Please consider inviting a friend or a group of friends to join you for the conversations prompted by "Character Matters!" If you are a host let our office know (cbi18@cbi18.org). If a host has not yet invited you, please consider contacting our office and we will match you with a group.

Wishes to you and your family for a good and sweet new year; a new year of elevating and happy-making conversations. ☆
