

RABBI SPITZ'S MESSAGE



Why I Love the Psalms?

love the Psalms. In some ways, it is a new found love. I have chanted Psalms as part of traditional prayer, but only recently did I begin to delve deeply into these spiritual poems. I did so, because of Zoom and participants who have motivated me to spend hours in preparation for each of our half-hour classes.

When COVID shutdowns began in March, I considered that in times of distress our tradition directs us to chant these poems to God. So began a Zoom class for a half hour three days a week to study one Psalm at a time. It had never occurred to me before to teach only a half-hour class due to the investment of time needed to get to the synagogue. Now with Zoom, I began to come to my fellow learner's homes and with no driving time!

Preparing for each of the Psalm classes is a journey. I begin by delving into as many as ten translation to uncover the Psalmist's message and artful weave. I then craft my own translation. Doing so has sharpened my awareness of how Hebrew and English differ. In Biblical Hebrew, there are only two tenses: perfect (past and present) and imperfect (present, future, and jussive/let's). As a result, translations differ as to tense. Also, in Hebrew there is no capitalization of pronouns. When the text says "he" the translator is left to discern if God or a person is the focus. Here too, translations are interpretations with distinctive choices. And last. Hebrew's vocabulary is much more limited than English, which has absorbed vocabulary from many languages. When the verb used is shelach, possible translations can be send, cast, throw, or fling- each conveying in English a subtle nuance. And by virtue of a more limited vocabulary with shared roots for multiple meanings. Hebrew allows for more wordplays. Remarkably, there are in Hebrew many more names for God, each a metaphor.

What makes Psalms distinctive is precisely that they are written to God and meant to be heard by spiritual peers. As a result, the words are often profoundly personal

and honest and seek both to convey yearnings of the speaker and to uplift or challenge others. Reading the Psalms is a form of prayer, an expression that begins with the self and then goes beyond the self. The authorship of any Psalm is unknown, although close to half are attributed to King David, who reigned over three-thousand-years ago. Most of the Psalms, scholars teach, were written much later than King David, but ascribed to him as both a model king and as a singer of hymns to God. In each class, our study leads to the question, How are these words personally relevant? Consistently, the Psalms resonate as giving voice to essential aspects of our own lives.

All of my presentations are posted on our website. On our Home page, click on Psalm a Day listed on our Highlighted Events list. Please consider joining me for a class on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday at 9:30am. And if you would like to learn at your convenience, please check out the zoom recordings. We are now in the middle of the Psalms. I intend to complete the entire set of 150 before ending my tenure at CBI in September.

To study the Psalms is to fall in love with spiritual expression and to more fully appreciate that we are bearers of a rich legacy. \$\Pi\$


